General Purpose of the Position:

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) will respond to and assess medical injuries and administer emergency medical care sustained during live training missions. Transport injured or sick persons to medical facilities. This position will report to the Program Manager.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Communicating with injured person and supervisors to determine nature of injuries and any pre-existing conditions
- Assessing medical injuries and making rapid decision regarding emergency treatment options
- Utilizing basic medical equipment, such as bandages, splints, and backboards
- Observe, record, and report to physician the patient's condition or injury, the treatment provided, and reactions to drugs and treatment.
- Comfort and reassure patients.
- Carrying or lifting injured persons
- Assisting Mission Manager with the completion of required documents, including Workers' Compensation forms

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Knowledge of the information and techniques needed to diagnose and treat human injuries, diseases, and deformities. This includes symptoms, treatment alternatives, drug properties and interactions, and preventive health-care measures.
- Skilled in communicating orally and in written form
- Ability to react quickly and calmly in stressful situations
- Ability to travel to various work locations in the U.S.
- Ability to work outdoors in a variety of weather conditions

Minimum Qualifications:



- One (1) year experience working as an EMT
- Valid driver's license
- Current EMT Certification by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) and /or applicable state agencies
- Preferred candidates will have military experience

Working Environment: Work is performed in field operations, outdoors in a variety of weather conditions, and around controlled explosions.

Physical Demands: position consists of sitting, bending, kneeling, stooping, crouching, and lifting of 50lbs. [Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions].
